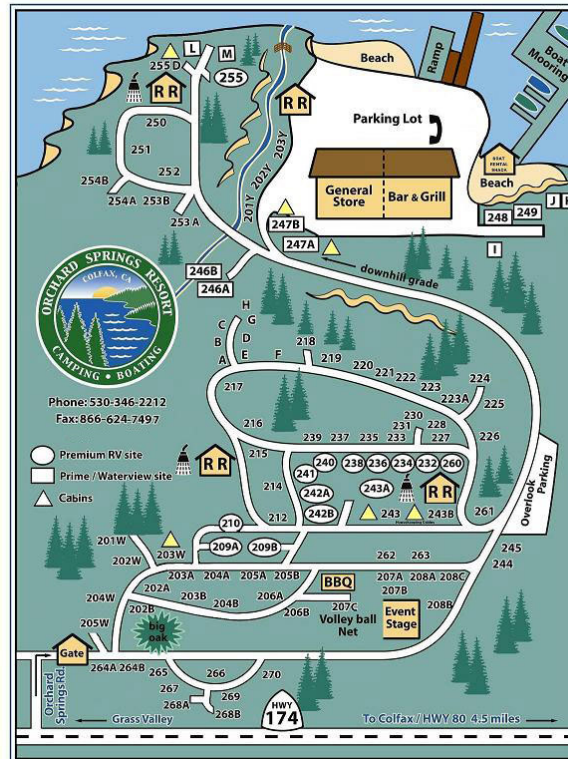
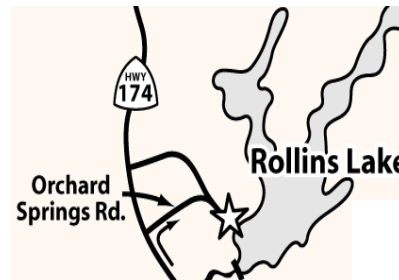

Directions:

From Chico take CA-99 South. Stay straight to go onto CA-149 S. CA-149 S becomes CA-70 S. Turn left onto woodruff Lane and stay on Woodruff Lane. Turn left onto CA-20/Browns Valley Road and continue to follow CA-20. Merge onto CA-20/CA-49 N via the ramp on the left. Take the Idaho Maryland Road exit (exit 182B) and turn right onto Idaho Maryland Road. Turn right onto Brunswick Road. Turn left onto CA-174/Colfax Hwy. Turn left onto Orchard Springs Road. Orchard Springs Resort is on the right.

Accommodations:

Lake Rollins has a surface area of 900 acres, with 26 miles of shoreline. This is a great lake for sailing and water-skiing with many coves and long stretches of open water. Fishing is good from boat or shore for a wide variety of trout and warm water species. Orchard Springs Campground has 7 miles of shoreline, is 1 mile wide, 2 miles long and 80 to 100 feet deep at it's deepest point. Hot water showers and modern restrooms (handicapped accessible) are available in multiple areas of the campground.

Schedule:

Thursday, July 29th

Arrive (but come anytime that weekend if you cannot make it on Thursday! There will be plenty of tenting space.)

Every Day

Free time with optional scheduled activities. The beach is a wonderful place for children and adults. There are lots of opportunities for recreation of all sorts. Campfire time is every evening.

Sunday, August 1st Camp Ends

Breakfast & Lunch: On your own, except Saturday morning.

Camper Costs (payable to BPC)

Covers Tent camping, group activities, extra group food, and other program expenses

\$33.00/day for singles or couples

\$35.00/day for a family/group (up to 4 people)

Additional Tent Camping Costs (payable to BPC):

\$3/ per day for extra people over the age of 6

RVer Cost (payable to BPC)

Covers group activities, extra group food and other program expenses.

\$ 8.00/day for singles or couples

\$10.00/day for families

Other Costs (paid at the camp ground)

\$6.25/day – vehicle

25 cents - 3 minute shower

\$6.50/day - boats

\$20/day - boat slip costs
