Lake Siskiyou Camp-Resort is located near the town of Mt. Shasta City. Take I-5 North to Mt. Shasta. As you approach Mt. Shasta, take the CENTRAL exit. Go west (away from the mountain) to the Stop sign at Old Stage Road. Turn left; bear right in 1/4 mile at fork (onto W.A. Barr Road). Continue on W. Q. Barr Road for 3.5 miles (around the lake), until you see the resort sign on your right.

We're looking forward to enjoying lots of relaxation time and fun activities together! Activities will include:

## Accommodations:

Lake Siskiyou, a 430-acre recreational and sailing lake fed by 5 pure mountain streams, has a 600 foot swimming beach, and offers some of the best bass and trout fishing in Northern California. Lake Siskiyou Camp-Resort, a 250-acre pine-shaded campground provides full restrooms with coin-operated hot showers, laundry facilities, dump station, propane dispenser, general store, and full hook-ups for RVs.

## Cost:

### **Program Cost Per Night:**

(covers group activities, extra group food, and other program expenses)

\$8.00 for singles or couples

\$10.00 for a family or group (3+ people)

### **Campground Cost:**

Lake Siskiyou Camp-Resort is a private campground, so individuals and families pay on an individual basis:

#### **Tents:**

Individuals 6 years and older: \$3/night; Vehicles: \$5/night.

#### **\*RVs (up to 42 feet):**

full hook-ups (electricity, water, sewer): \$29/night for 2 people

#### **\*Tent Campers and cab-over Campers:**

\$25.50/night for 2 people (electricity & water)

**\* Super Important!** Anyone who is NOT tent camping (all RVs, campers, etc) must call the campground ASAP to reserve a site. Be sure to ask to be as close as possible to Group sites G3 or G5

## Schedule:

### **Thursday, July 30th**

Arrive (but come anytime that weekend if you cannot make it on Thursday! There will be plenty of tenting space.)

### **Every Day**

Free time with optional scheduled activities. The beach is a wonderful place for children and adults. There are lots of opportunities for recreation of all sorts. Campfire time is every evening.

### **Sunday, August 3rd Camp Ends**

## Meals (more details to come in July):

**Breakfast & Lunch:** On your own

**Thursday Dinner:** Main dish provided. Campers contribute salad/side dish and dessert.

**Friday Dinner:** Potluck—campers bring a main dish and salad or side dish to share; ice cream social!

**Saturday Dinner:** Stone Salad (a Camp Bidwell tradition). Campers contribute ingredients (for the best salad you've ever tasted!), and bring bread or dessert item to share.
