Week 3 "Who Will Go For Us?"
Isaiah 6:1-8

OPEN WITH PRAYER

GETTING STARTED:

Talk about a time when you had your breath taken away by some person, event, or place. What was that experience like? What was it about that thing that took your breath away?

LEARNING & APPLYING GOD'S WORD

Together, read Isaiah 6:1-8

1. Based on this scene, what words would you use to describe God?

2. Put yourself in Isaiah's shoes. How would you feel? What would you think if you were him?

3. How did Isaiah respond to this scene in verse 5? Why do you suppose he responded this way?

4. What is God's response to Isaiah's response? What does this tell you about the nature and ways of God?

5. God makes his concern for Israel known in Isaiah 1:10-17. What were those concerns?

6. What does Isaiah 1:10-17 tell you about the kind of ministry Isaiah was called to? How does this apply to followers of Jesus today?

LIVING OUT “REAL LIFE”

7. Sometimes God calls us to go serve and proclaim the gospel in far away places. But, like in Isaiah’s case, God calls us to serve and proclaim right here among our own people. It just takes awakening to the opportunities right in front of us. What opportunities to serve and proclaim might God be calling you to awaken to this coming week?

8. What *specific actions* will you take this coming week to fulfill God’s call to serve and proclaim the gospel this coming week?

SHARING AND PRAYER (Prayer Requests)

Before praying for the needs of your group, pray a prayer of “commissioning” or “sending” for each person in your group in their call to serve others this week. Once you are done commissioning each other, then feel free to pray for the needs of the group.
