Ephesians 6:19-24

THE BIG IDEA: God calls us to be ambassadors of his grace wherever we are, even in light of what might hold us back.

OPEN WITH PRAYER

GETTING STARTED: What's the most significant event you're ever witnessed? What do you remember best about it? Who was the first person you told?

LEARNING & APPLYING GOD'S WORD

Together, read Ephesians 6:19-24

1. What was one point from Greg's sermon Sunday that you particularly remember? Why?
2. Paul repeats his call for the church to **pray**? Why is prayer important for Paul? Why is it still important for us today? What does prayer mean to you?
3. In verse 20, Paul describes being an **ambassador in chains**. Ambassadors represent their home country wherever they are. How does that affect Paul? What else does it mean to be an ambassador?
4. What kind of chains prevent you from seeing yourself as an ambassador for the Kingdom of God? Are you held down by self-doubt? Laziness? Fear? Personal struggles? What else? How can God help you overcome those chains and give witness to your faith?
5. In verses 23 and 24, Paul talks about **peace** and **grace**. How would you define those words?
6. In all of Paul's letters, he repeats the need for the churches to experience grace and peace. How does God free us when we experience his peace and grace?

LIVING OUT “REAL LIFE”

7. Is there a way that taking on the role of an ambassador for Christ could change your perspective on what you do every day?
8. What would you pray so that your life would more clearly reflect the Gospel where you live or work? So that you could witness to God’s grace to those around you in word and in your life?

SHARING AND PRAYER (Prayer Requests)

Take some time to share prayer requests, where you need to find God’s grace and peace. Be sure to give thanks for each other and pray for one another needs. When we pray together, we find the power of God.
