GETTING STARTED:

LEARNING & APPLYING GOD'S WORD

Together, read Luke 9:10-17 together

1. What was Jesus' motivation for teaching and healing on this day, even though he and his disciples were tired?
2. Why did Jesus decide to feed the people rather than dismiss them earlier?
3. Why didn't he create bread and fish from nothing? Why did he ask the disciples to find what they could?
4. What is the significance of the command, "You give them something to eat?"
5. Jim said that as we place our ordinary lives into the hands of God, our lives become like a sacrament pointing to Christ, the one who will feed the masses through us. What keeps you from placing your ordinary life into his hands?

LIVING OUT “REAL LIFE”

1. Examine your daily routine. What part of your day can you allow God to use to “feed” others? Make an intentional plan to surrender that part of your day to be used by God this week.
