OPEN WITH PRAYER

GETTING STARTED: What does it mean to be “well” or “healthy”? Have you seen Jesus bring health to people’s lives? How?

LEARNING & APPLYING GOD’S WORD

Together, read Luke 7:1-10 together

1. What’s one point from the sermon that struck you? Why?
2. How does this passage relate to last week’s where Jesus reminded us to build our lives on the rock of his word?
3. The centurion was a Roman military officer (something like today’s sergeant), who had authority over 100 men. From verses 7 and 8, how did the centurion understand authority? How did this help him grasp Jesus’ authority?
4. In verse 9, Jesus marvels at the centurion’s faith. What do you think particularly strikes Jesus?
5. In this passage, Jesus heals the servant of an outsider, a Gentile. What does this tell you about the ministry of Jesus with the outsider? How does it speak to Bidwell Presbyterian Church?
6. How does Jesus touch our lives and make us well?

LIVING OUT “REAL LIFE”

1. Where do you need healing? How can your RLG or small group help you find healing in Christ?
2. Who near you needs to be touched and made well by Jesus?
