3. The first question the lawyer asks Jesus is, "What must I do to gain eternal life?" What is the connection between being a good neighbor and having eternal life based Jesus' response.
4. Jim said that good neighbors cross boundaries. What boundaries did the Samaritan cross?

5. Jim mentioned 3 kinds of boundaries good neighbors cross: cultural, fear, and personal. Describe your understanding of each of these boundaries.

6. Which of these 3 boundaries keeps you from being a neighbor to others?
