4. How do we love and care for the "Pharisees and Religious leaders" of today?
5. "A physician can only help those who know they are sick..." It is easy for us to think or pretend we have it all together. The reality is that we all have the terminal diagnosis of SIN. How are you in need of the healing touch of God today?
