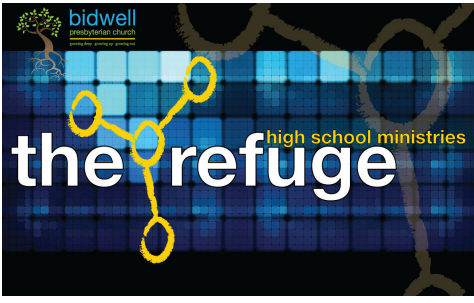

What is a Deep Justice Grant?

We believe that every student has something to offer to the least, last and the lost. The Refuge Deep Justice Grant is one way we want to support our students' in their journey to discover their passions and gifts. It is our hope that every student will find a way to love and care for others during the summer of 2010. We want to support our students to be involved in local and foreign mission and service opportunity. Grants can be applied for as individuals or as a part of a group mission project.

What is the difference between an investment grant and a support grant?

An **INVESTMENT GRANT** is when you request funds for a project that will eventually be paid back. This grant is for if you find a ministry/mission opportunity that you would like to raise support for but need money to get the project off the ground. For example, You want to raise money to build water wells in Africa by doing a fundraiser by selling cookies. You could apply for a grant to pay for all of the supplies to create your cookies and sell them. As your money comes in, you would repay our grant and give all of the excess to your initial project, ie the water well. An investment grant is essentially a loan to get your project up and running.

A **SUPPORT GRANT** is a straight donation to support your ministry/mission idea. You would like to start a free neighborhood soccer camp for a week during the summer. You could apply for a grant to fund all of the supplies for the camp.

How do I apply for a grant?

You will need to fill out an application, be available for a potential interview, and commit to communicating the result of your project when you have completed it. Your grant application will be reviewed by the Bidwell Presbyterian Youth staff and/or BPC Youth Ministry Support team.

THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS MUST BE TYPED AND ATTACHED TO THIS APPLICATION IN ORDER TO HAVE YOUR GRANT REQUEST CONSIDERED.

1. Describe your mission project.
2. Why have you chosen this project?
3. What is the overall goal and objective of your project.
4. What is the Target population of your project? (i.e., who will benefit and/or take part in the project) and approximate number of people it will reach)
5. How does this project address issues of injustice? (*i.e., dismantling racism, poverty, hunger, peace, worker justice, globalization, environmental justice, etc.*)
6. What is budget for the project which includes projected expenditures and all actual and/or projected sources of funding? (*let us know if you need assistance figuring this out!*)
7. How will a BPC Youth Justice grant help you achieve your goal?
8. What will be in the impact on the project if you are not given a grant?
9. What do you hope to gain personally from leading/participating in this project?
10. In what other ways can we support your project as a youth group?
