## THE BIG IDEA

The Great Commission unifies the fractured uncommon fellowship and is the antidote to our shortcomings. It is the mission that draws us together, not because we do things the same, but because we are all pointed in the same direction--the direction where we are looking for Jesus where others’ don’t see Him and then simply pointing Him out!

7. Where is a place or who are people that God has uniquely equipped you to help see Jesus? How can you begin to lean into this place or people?

8. How will you “go” this week? What is holding you back? How can this group support you in that mission?
